- Strong knowledge of back end programming languages and frameworks (Node.js / Express or ASP.NET Core) is required.
- Working knowledge of HTML, CSS, Javascript and other front end frameworks (React or Angular) is required.
- Experience with mobile app development is a plus.
- Experience with wearable electronic products, particularly medical devices or scientific instruments is a plus.

- Experience working in a regulated industry and an understanding of Quality Management System requirements is a plus.
